- 2 pedestrians killed; one at (Cascade) BP and one in the business corridor
- W. Ontario has had lots of gun activity lately
- Neighbor concerned with the quality of officers being recruited...she witnessed an officer speaking to a neighbor with unacceptable language.
- Zone 4 is severely understaffed. In order to money budgeted to receive more police patrol, we have to give the city the data they need by calling to have incidents documented.
